In the *Courageous* movie, four men recognize a need and boldly answer the call to be better fathers. While these fellow law-enforcement officers consistently give their best on their job, "good enough" seems to be all they can muster as dads. But they're quickly discovering that their standard is missing the mark. They know that God desires to turn the hearts of fathers to their children, but their children are beginning to drift further and further away from them. Will they be able to find a way to serve and protect those who are most dear to them?

Sound familiar?? While this Bible study targets dads and a return to Biblical fatherhood, the material is for all learners whether you have children or not. Even without kids of their own, everyone has a physical father, and the relationship we have with our dads has powerful implications on how we operate as believers in Christ. That's why this study is important for women as well.
